Specific Responsibilities:

- Prep aerospace components and aviation parts per customer blueprints and specifications
- Bodywork composite fuselage and fairings
- Mask aircraft in preparation for primer and paint
- Prime both metal and composite components
- Apply customer-specified schemes
- Buff and final detail on finished products
- Inspect and monitor equipment for unsafe operations
- Maintain a clean and safe work area

- Ability to identify imperfections and remedy them
